**Footnotes**

HAZASPITTIN' IMAGE forced in at the start, raced off the pace, moved wide in the stretch and was up in the late stages. SPARTAK came in at the start, split rivals rallying in the stretch too late. CRUISE CONTROL settled off the pace, bid to the front in the stretch then was outfinished. LT. COLUMBO saved ground off the leaders, loomed a threat then flattened out in the final furlong. LITTLE TOWN BLUES lacked speed, moved inside in the stretch and continued well. BOURBONATBOYLESBAR raced close up outside and gave way on the final turn. TIZ A DATE set a clear pace for three quarters then stopped abruptly. SUNSHINE CRUSADER forced in at the start, brushed the rail on the first turn and was no factor. LOUIE'S WISH prompted the pace outside to the stretch then gave way. JOE FLASH dropped back early and was always outrun.
